Our office is pleased to offer unpaid internships to qualified college students and recent graduates. We are able to sign off on academic credit if offered, and will provide letters of recommendation if the student's performance is sufficient. Space in the office is limited to only one of two interns for semester and through the summer, which makes the application process highly competitive. Applications are accepted year-round; however interested persons should apply as early as possible.

Capitol Hill is a wonderful way to see how Congress operates first-hand. An internship in a Congressional office provides an exciting educational experience. Congressional offices are small and the staff is constantly managing changing issues. Interns provide basic assistance to the staff by assisting with constituent mail, answering and directing telephone inquiries, helping with research, running errands and a handful of other tasks.
